# Freestyle competition rules

#### I. Definitions

- 1. Intelligent Autonomous Vehicle electro-mechanical construction capable of moving and performing actions autonomously
- 2. Competitor member of a registered team
- 3. Organizer Department of Robotics and Decision Systems, Faculty of Electronics, Telecommunications and Informatics at the Gdańsk University of Technology
- 4. Construction vehicle qualified for the competition.

#### II. Goal

1. The main purpose of the competition is to promote the flying and driving of autonomous vehicles built by qualified teams.

### III. Competition requirements

- Registration for the competition may take place via the organizer's webpage: https://eti.pg.edu.pl/safeidea/iav-cup-2018/en
- 2. Qualified teams will receive confirmation from the organizer by email
- 3. In the absence of a team member, substitution is possible provided that the team notifies the organizer at least 3 days before the event
- 4. The team can consist of up to 8 members
- 5. The presented construction cannot be stationary, i.e. it must be a vehicle.

## IV. Competition schedule

- 1. Each team should present the operation of their vehicle for 20 minutes (5 minutes for preparation and 15 minutes for the presentation, and perhaps some questions from the main referee)
- 2. Schedule will be provided on the organizer's webpage
- 3. Each vehicle/presentation will be rated on a scale of 1-5 in the following categories:
  - a) Complexity of the problem
  - b) Solution for the stated problem
  - c) Technology/Innovation
  - d) Intelligence
  - e) Presentation quality
- 4. The final ranking of the winners (including tie cases) is the responsibility of the main referee (using weighted results in the above categories)
- 5. During the competition, each team can organize exhibition of their vehicle
- 6. The organizer provides access to the electricity network on request.

## V. Prizes

1. Top three teams will receive an award.

## VI. Final provisions

- 1. The organizer is allowed to change the rules before the competition
- 2. Matters not mentioned in these rules will be resolved by the main referee
- 3. It is not possible to appeal from the decision of the main referee
- 4. The organizer is not responsible for damage caused to the vehicles during the competition
- 5. In case of bad weather conditions, the organizer may change the place and/or time of the competition.
